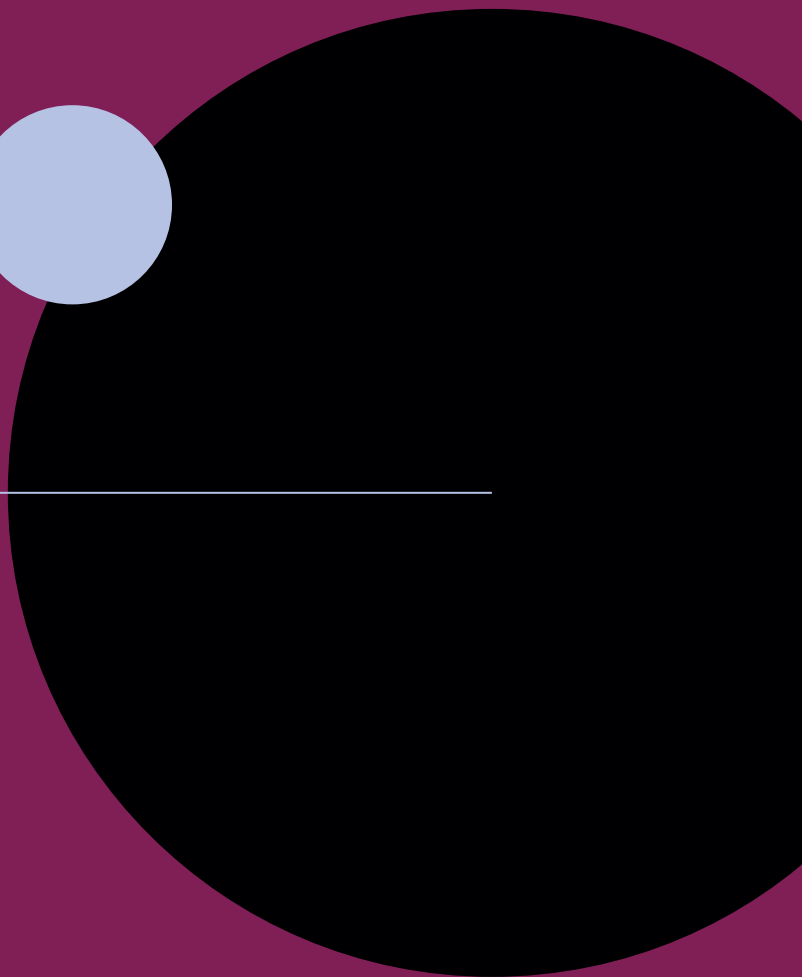
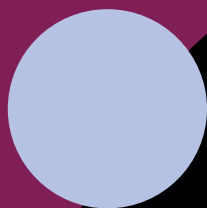
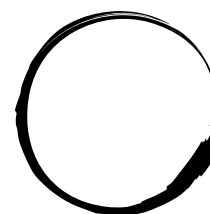

Responsibility also means considering not only the final product, but the impact we leave on our environment.

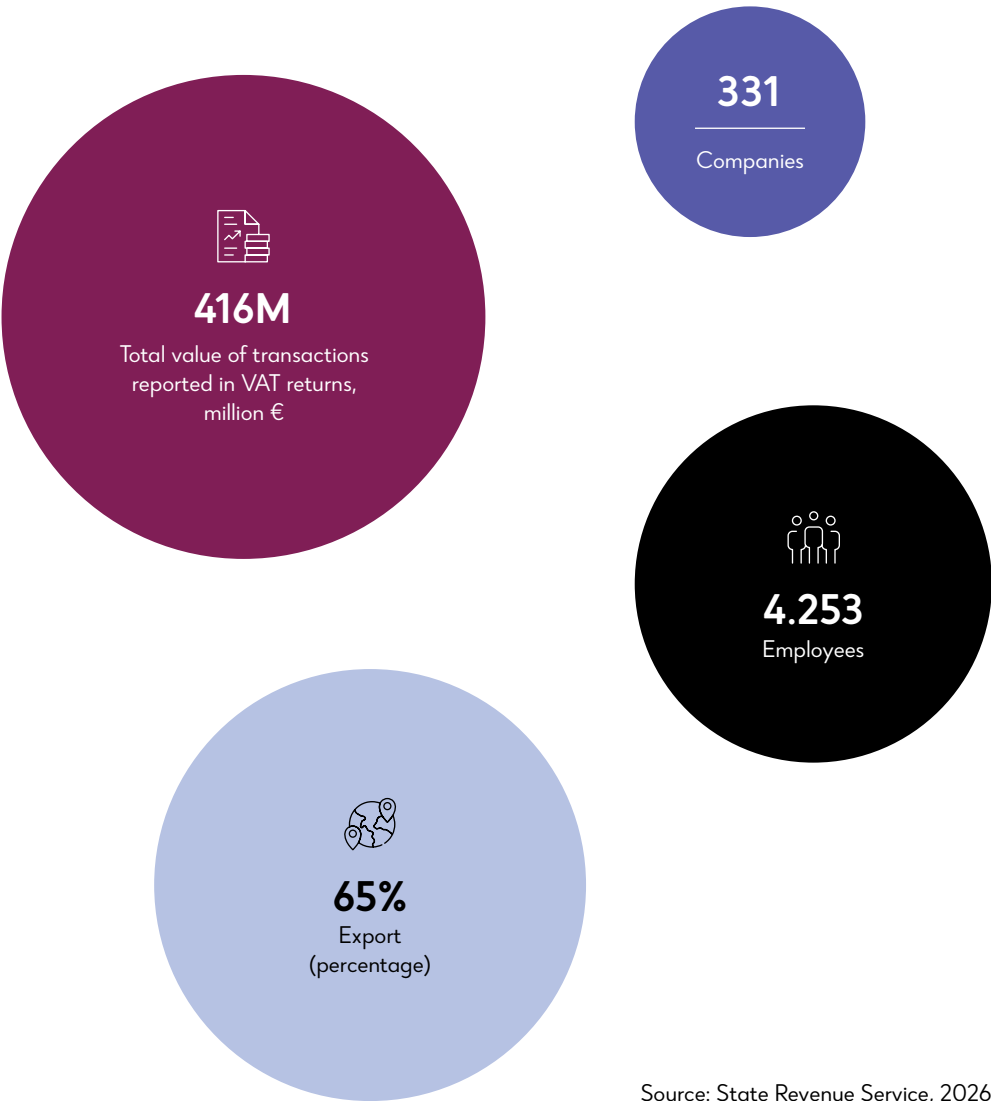
Reliability is the foundation of long-term partnerships that our companies have built over the years, both locally and internationally.

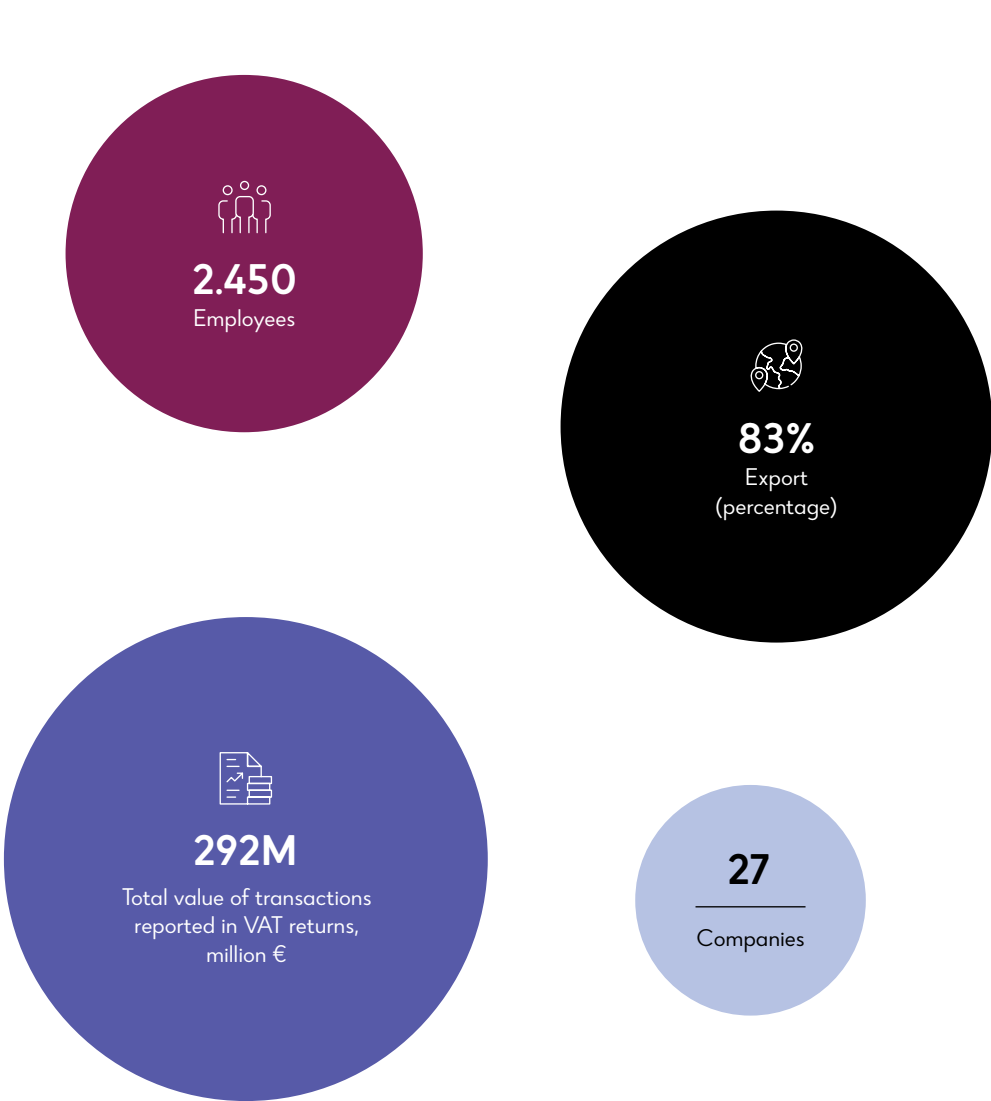
Latvian graphics industry, 2025

Mission & industry impact

The Association represents industry interests both locally and internationally, promoting Latvian printing as a modern, high-tech, and eco-friendly sector that supports culture and education. Member companies employ diverse printing and finishing technologies to produce a wide array of products. Notably, over 80% of the output produced by LPA members is exported worldwide.

02

Governance structure

According to the statutes, the association's highest governing body is the General Meeting of Members. Every three years, it elects an executive body – a Board of nine members, led by the Chairperson and two deputies. An Audit Committee of two members monitors the association's activities, while daily operations are coordinated by the Executive Director.

03

Working groups & advisory role

Special working groups have been established to address various industry issues. Experts from the LPA Advisory Council evaluate print quality in case of disputes, providing opinions on compliance with standard target values. They also provide consultations on drafting public and private procurement regulations and evaluating tender results. The Education Working Group focuses on professional development, further education, and attracting youth to the industry, while the Environmental Working Group focuses on sustainability issues and environmental protection within the industry.

04

Industry communication

To keep members informed, a weekly electronic newsletter, "Iespiedgrafikas Ziņas" (Print Graphics News), is published. Once a year, the "Print Day" event takes place, where the performance of the association and its member companies is reviewed and the best are awarded. An annual spring meeting between companies and students of the Riga State Technical School's Department of Printing and Media Technology has also become a tradition. Industry specialists help develop curricula, qualifications, and exams, while LPA coordinates EU-funded cooperation and skills projects.

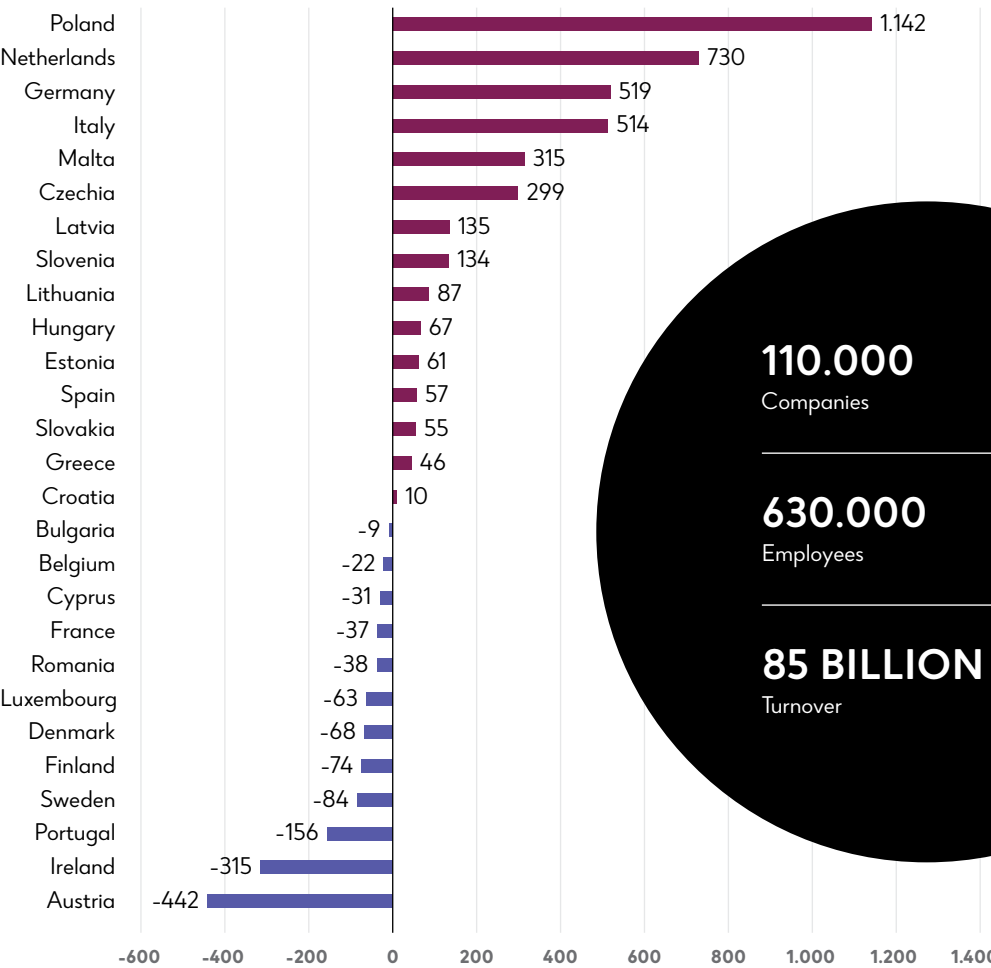

■ Net importers of printed products

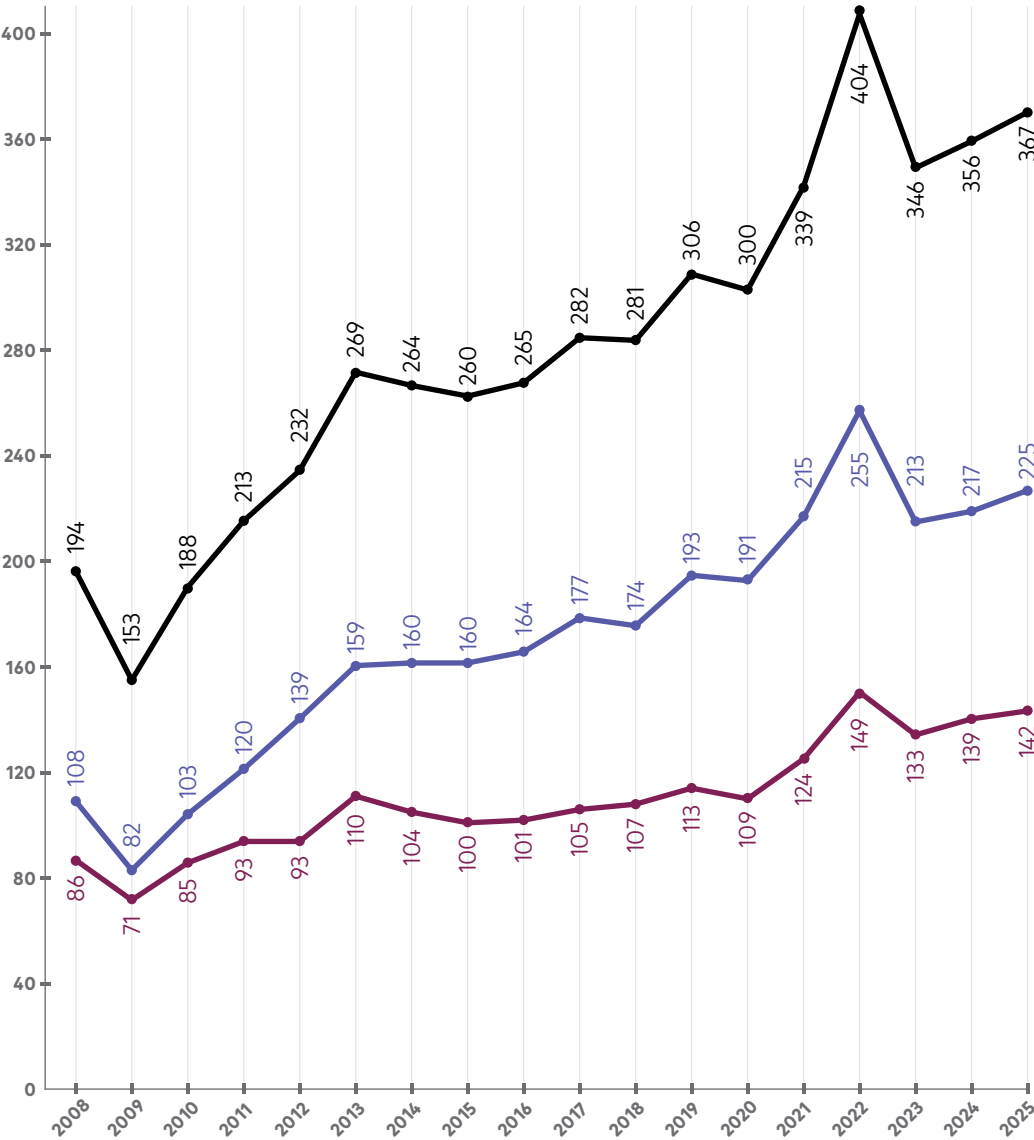

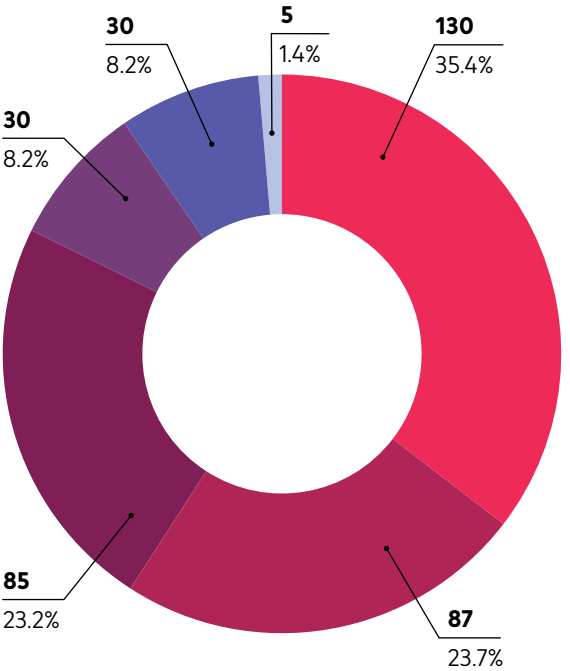
Turnover dynamics by year (million EUR)

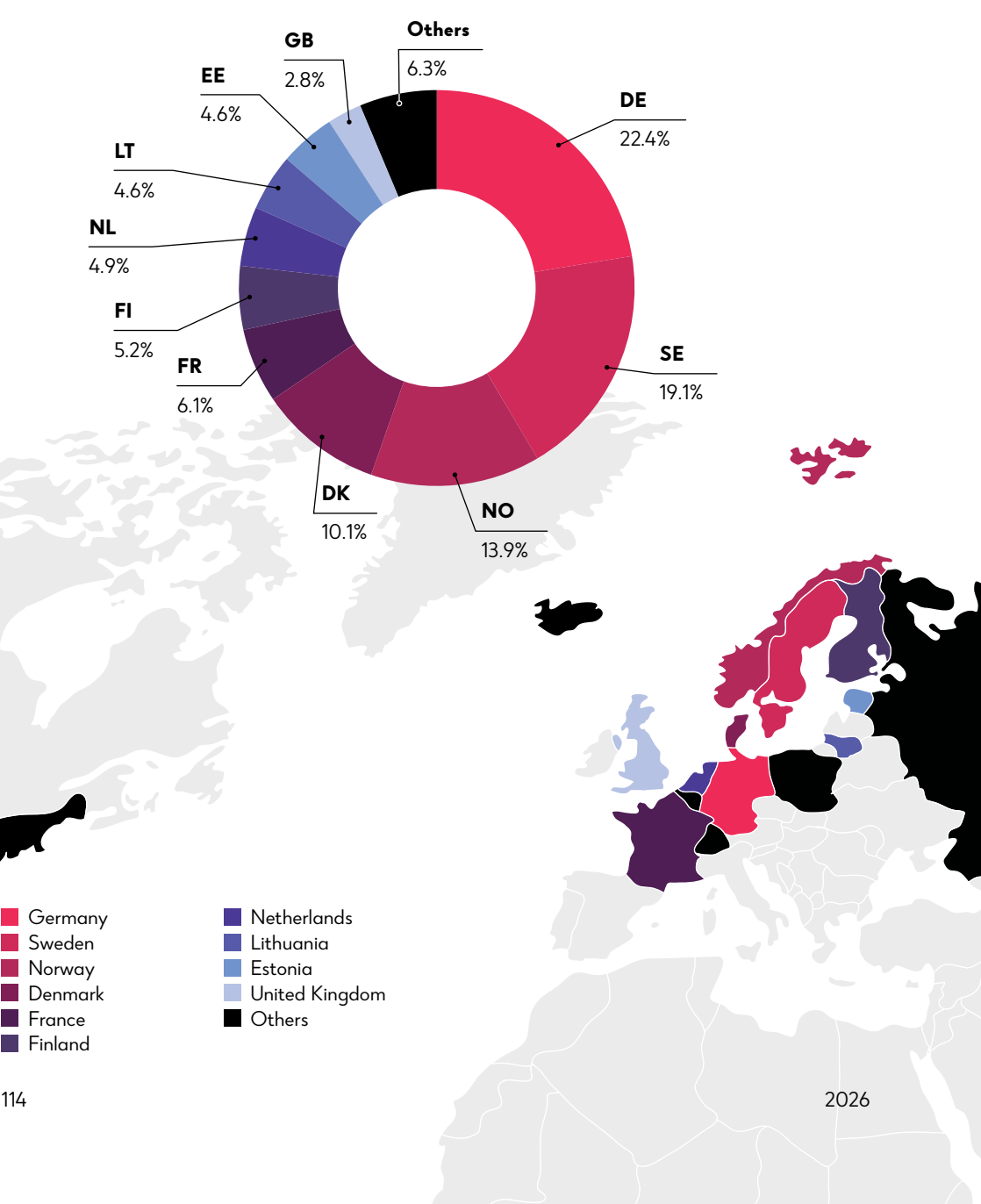

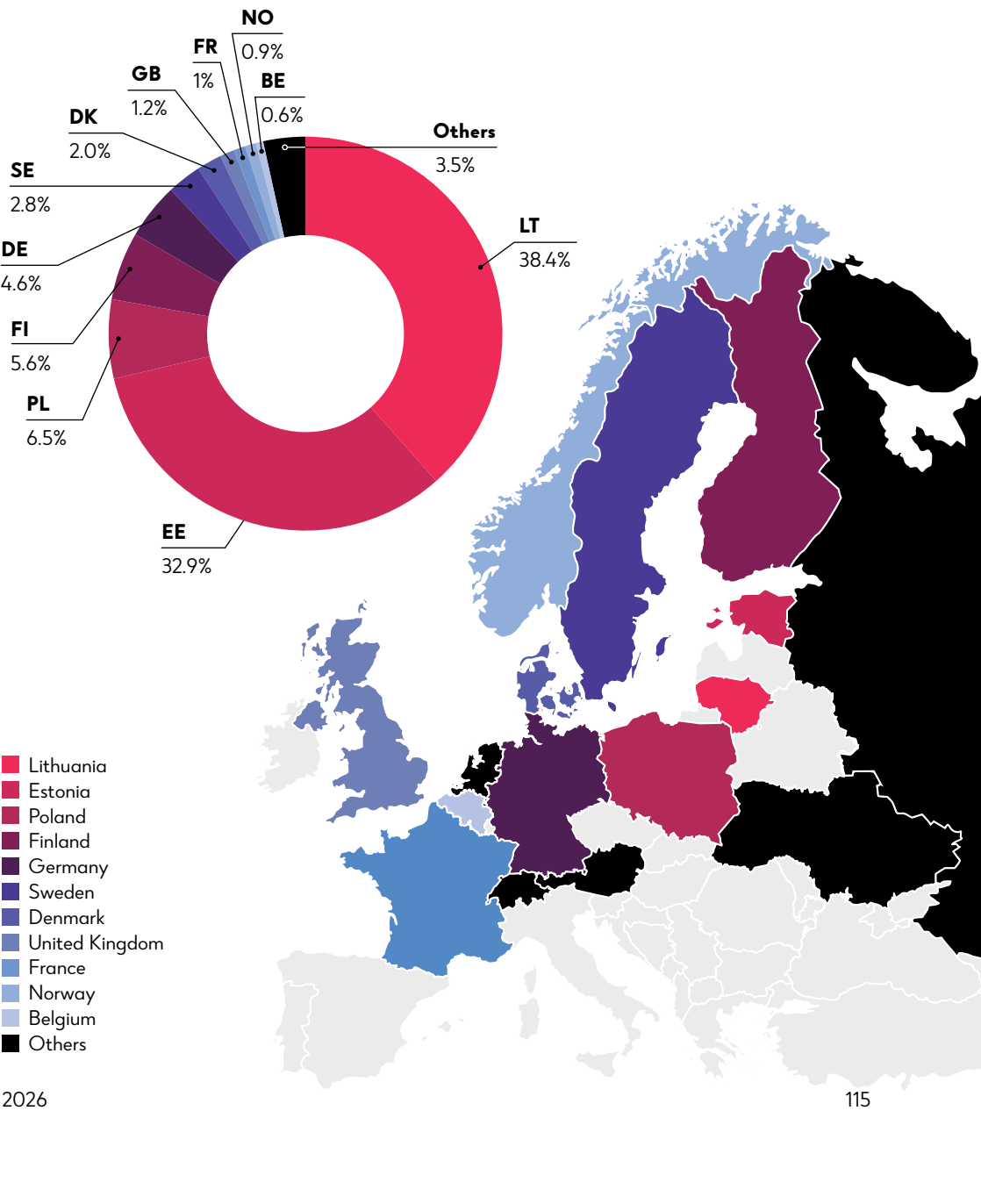

Printing industry in Latvia

01

Latvia joined the European printing community in **1588**, when the first master printer, Nicolaus Mollyn, arrived in Riga from Antwerp. He was granted the exclusive privilege to print books not only for Riga but for the entire region of Livonia. That same year, the first two printed works were produced in Riga. The Bible – the world's most widely published book – was first printed in Latvian in **1693**.



03

With the advancement of technology in the late 19th and early 20th centuries, the printed word became the primary medium for information in Latvia, fostering social development and the growth of national identity. In **1918**, the independent Republic of Latvia was founded, with a printing industry driven by private initiative acting as the main distributor of information.

From the beginning till our days

05

After Latvia regained independence in the **1990s**, the printing industry underwent rapid transformation. State-owned printing houses were privatized, new companies emerged, modern technologies were introduced, and the sector successfully embraced digitalization. In **1997**, the Association of Latvian Printing Companies was founded.



02

In **1769**, Johann Friedrich Steffenhagen took over the Duke of Courland's printing house in Jelgava, transforming it into the Baltics' largest and publishing many first Latvian-language editions. This printing tradition has continued for nearly 350 years.



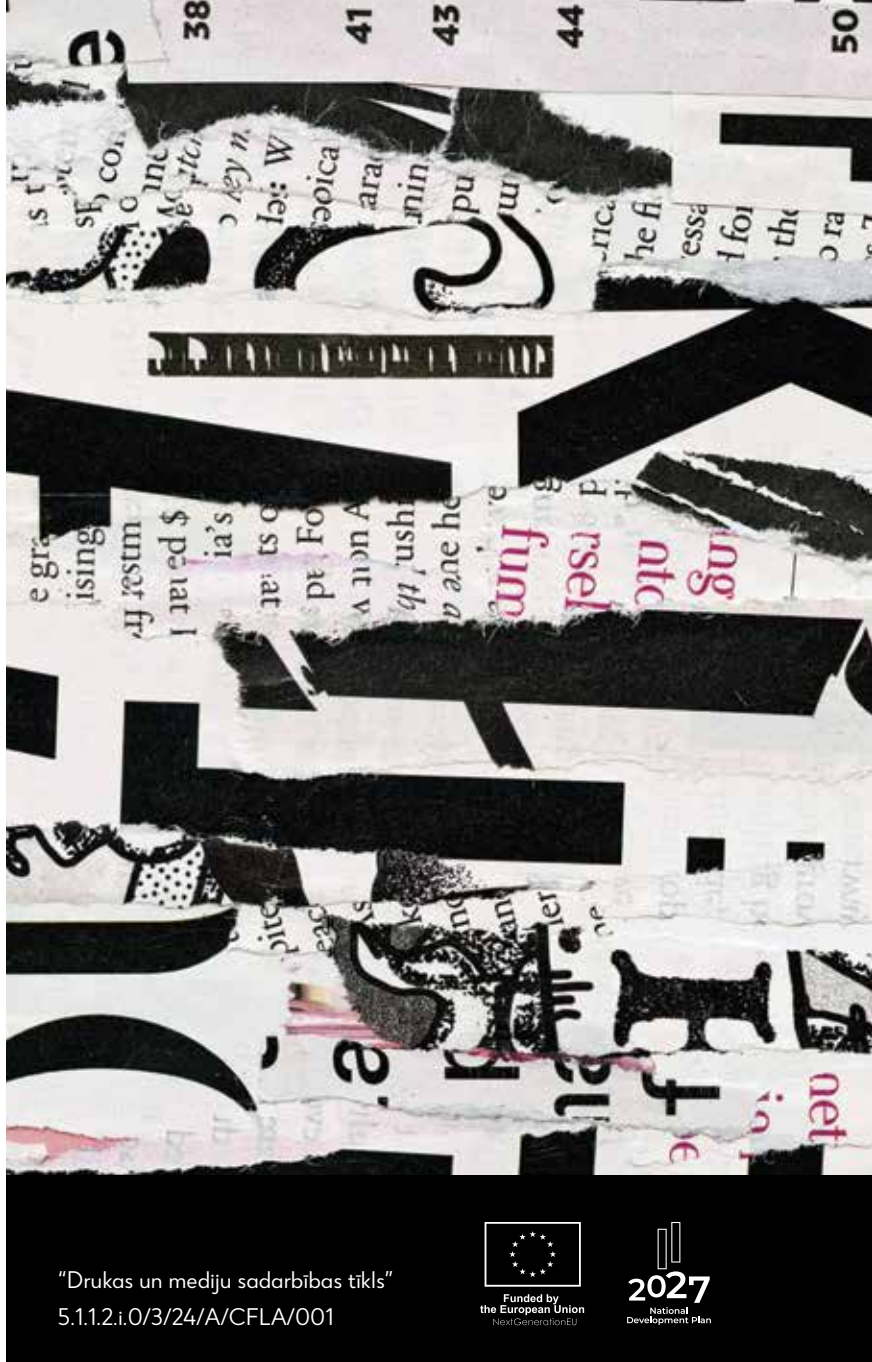

After the Soviet occupation in **1940**, Latvia's printing industry was nationalized and heavily censored for fifty years, while anti-occupation publications were produced illegally. In **1991**, Soviet forces occupied the Press House, the center of Latvia's printing industry.



06

After recovering from the **2008** global economic crisis, Latvia's printing industry became a major export sector, driven by modern technology, quality production, and continuous investment in automation. Latvian printers also actively contribute to INTERGRAF.
